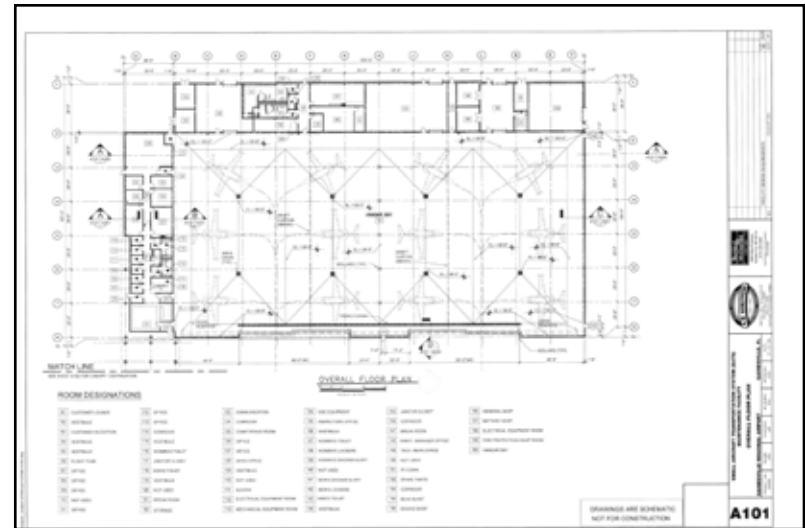

SERVICE CENTER - FLOOR PLAN

Gainesville Regional Airport built a state-of-the-art Aircraft Service Center in 2007. The 61,000 square-foot Center and 90-space, paved automobile parking lot is located on the southwest quadrant of airport property. It consists of approximately 45,000 square-feet of air-conditioned hangar space. Support areas include a 10,800 square-foot maintenance section and a 5,400 square-foot customer service area. The height of the hangar doors (24 feet) and thickness of the hangar floor accommodates mid-size corporate aircraft such as the Canadair Challenger 604 Series and regional airlines such as the CRJ200 and ERJ 145.



SERVICE CENTER - HANGAR FEATURES

The hangar features a state-of-the-art fire suppression system, electric hangar doors, and an HVAC system. The hangar doors are 80 feet wide.

The facility includes a three-phase, 2,000 amp main electrical distribution panel, lightning protection, and compressed air and three-phase power distributed to aircraft servicing locations throughout the hangar. All floors are coated with a chemical resistant, epoxy-urethane finish. Additional amenities include a security system, emergency



shower and eye wash stations, floor drains and an oil

water separator. The Center has multiple areas dedicated to the storage and receipt of aircraft supplies and parts, with a roll-up door that can accommodate large deliveries.

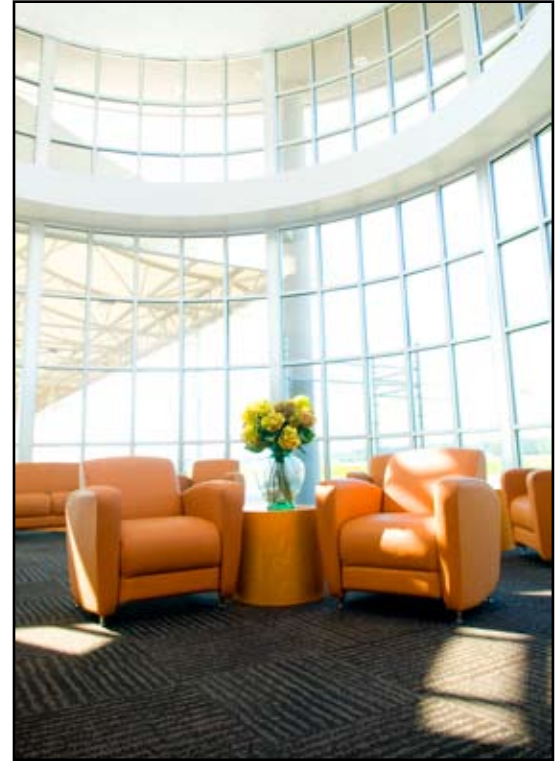






SERVICE CENTER - LOBBY

The customer entrance and lobby features a glass rotunda, allowing natural light and providing an architecturally unique entrance. The modern style provides a first-class reception and waiting area for customers. It features a built-in customer service desk and is accessible from the aircraft ramp, hangar, land-side parking area and corridor that leads to the customer office areas and meeting rooms.





SERVICE CENTER - AMENITIES

The Center includes an 1,150 square foot open work area, multiple meeting rooms, two break rooms with plentiful dining space, four restrooms and two with showers, a 329 square foot conference room and six private computer offices for customers and pilots.

HANGAR - EXTERIOR

The Service Center, occupying 5.4 acres, boasts its presence at the airport and is visible from State Road 24 (Waldo Road). The Service Center also has a 57,000 square foot, exclusive parking apron with an 11,300 square-foot architectural fabric canopy for aircraft parking.
